

Once again, Nunnery is delighted that our fantastic Year 11 students have gained a great set of results. Scores for English and Maths are way above national averages. Almost a third of grades overall were 7 or above – that is, old fashioned A grades or A\*s.

Attainment 8 – the quality of grades across the board – is 52 which is significantly above the national average.

Most importantly, our progress scores across the board are superb – showing that everyone one of our students matter to us and that the progress students make here – Progress 8 - puts the school amongst the very best in the country.
